## We provide:

- Impartial & confidential advice and information for Children and Young People on SEND around Education, Health and Care.
- We offer support with Education, Health and Care plans, personal budgets, person centred planning and how to use the Local Offer.
- Support with writing letters and completing forms, and assistance with discussions and meetings with schools, the Local Authority SEN team and other professionals.
- Support with resolving disagreements helping you to consider and determine the best way forward.
- Information and signposting to support services in your area.
- Support with Transition and preparing for Adulthood.
- Promote independence and self-advocacy for young people whilst advocating on the young person's behalf where necessary.
- We listen to your views and concerns, explore your options and rights (without pressure), and provide information to help make informed decisions.
